PASTOR KARL'S NOTES

Make the Connection with Stewardship

Dear Church Family,

My father worked as an engineer on the Space Shuttle program when I was growing up. Being an engineer's kid, it meant that one of the requisite toys I received from him was an Electronic Lab from Radio Shack. These were plastic boards that had small spring clips all over the surface and little pieces of wire. The idea was that you picked a project out of the book, connected all the wires to the spring clips in the right configuration, and it would transform the board into an AM radio or a light switch or a musical instrument through electronic circuitry.

Now, I didn't become an engineer, but I did learn a great deal about *connection*. You could spend half an hour putting all the wires in place, but if just one connection was off, the whole thing wouldn't work. Connections are important in electronics but even more so in our walk as deeply committed followers of Jesus Christ.

As a church, we are about to begin our planning for the 2017-18 year of ministry which always begins with our spring stewardship series. Last year, we *Reset* our understanding of stewardship. This year, we want to see our stewardship as a *connection* between our giving and our discipleship. Stewardship is more than a financial pledge. It's a pledge to support God's ministry through serving as disciples in the life of the church.

Our theme this year is *Connect*. Over the next few Sundays we are going to be talking about the connection between the financial support you generously bless this church with and the concrete ways it allows us to be the hands and feet of Christ. We'll hear from people about the ways this church has touched their lives. You'll be updated on the "nuts and bolts" of our financial picture at Shepherd of the Hills. And you'll be invited to be part of the connection that will make ministry possible in the next year.

Be looking for more information coming in the mail as well as joining us each Sunday to see where God is connecting us together into the body of Christ. It's an exciting time and it becomes more clear to me each year that God will continue to do great things to build his Kingdom through the people of Shepherd of the Hills.

A History of the MV Sanctuary

Our original sanctuary is now known as the Youth Lounge. A service of dedication for this house of worship was held on August 30, 1970.

Prior to this, the congregation had been worshipping, since November 1, 1967, at Mission Viejo High School.

The cost of \$170,000.00 for the facility included the following: a multipurpose room, used for worship and social hall, nine classrooms, restrooms, offices, the fireside room and a small kitchen. The congregation numbered more than 300 members.

Our present sanctuary opened on Sunday, March 4, 1990. On Sunday, March 25, 1990 our sanctuary was consecrated. Some additional facts are:

- The total square feet of the building is 7,365.
- The cost of the building was \$1,500,000.00
- The height of the exterior cross is 22 feet, 6 inches, and is 66 feet, 11 inches from the base.
- Our interior cross, that we view as we enter the nave, is 10 by 4 feet and is made of steel and glass and is coated with gold paint.
- Our original organ was a Baldwin Digital Electronic and was first used in worship on January 13, 1991.
- The faceted windows behind the garden represent the seasons of the Christian year – Advent, Lent, Easter, Pentecost and Christmas, plus the United Methodist Symbol – the Cross and the Flame
- The windows along the side wall of the church, symbolize the sacraments of Baptism and Holy Communion plus Holy Matrimony.
