For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, which is Christ the Lord. And this shall be a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger. And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward [all.]

Dear Church Family,

Christmas is fast approaching, and while I often want it to be a slow arrival in order to get everything done, this year I'm ready for Christmas to be here. I'm ready not because of any presents I'm expecting or events I'm going to attend. I'm ready because I need to hear the Christmas story right now. I need to hear the words above that remind me, "Fear Not." I need to remember that there is still "good news of great joy for all the people" in this world because over the last few months, it's been very hard to hold on to that truth.

Even as I sit down to type this article (on November 14th), word of another shooting has come across my computer screen. My heart is so tired of aching for the pain we continue to see in our world, and my soul longs for a word of hope.

That's why I can't—and won't—wait for Christmas this year. While a group of rag-tag shepherds watched over their grazing flocks of sheep on the small hillside near the outskirts of Bethlehem, Angels appeared to bring them good news. But according to Luke, they had a hard time grasping the good news amongst the chaos that must have accompanied their arrival. The gospel tells us that the "glory of the Lord shone around them" and it must have knocked them over, because they were terrified. Their world was wrecked with chaos and confusion.

But the angel said, "Fear not!" Not because the chaos disappeared, but because born on that day was a baby who changed the world. And not just any baby, but "Christ the Lord." I know our world seems upside down, but it's for exactly that reason that we need to remember Christmas is with us always. We need to remember that Jesus came to save us and give us hope.

He saves us through the amazing grace and forgiveness we receive through his life, death, and resurrection. He rescues us from a life story where death has the final word and gives us a new story with life eternal. And most importantly, he brings us hope. Hope that this world can be changed. He brings us hope that comes when we literally love our neighbors—all our neighbors—as ourselves. And he brings us the command that, as his followers, we are not to believe that this world is hopeless. Jesus asks his followers to destroy hate with love in the same way he did during his ministry.

Friends, we cannot give up on this world. God's kingdom is meant to be "on earth as it is in heaven," and if we need a little early Christmas to remind us of that then let's celebrate early. Fear not! For God is with us.
