# Around the Church

## Communion on Sundays, July 7 / August 5

Communion will be served at both campuses on Sunday, July 7 and Sunday, August 4. The July 7 communion offering will go toward Campus Ministries. Campus Ministries are the missional presence of the United Methodist Church on college and university campuses around the world. Through a network of chaplaincies, Wesley Foundation's ecumenical ministries and church based ministries reaches more than 1,300 campuses around the world.

The August 7 communion offering will go towards World Hunger, helping reach out to those who are homeless, in poverty, and undernourished.

## Prayer Labyrinth at MV

In addition to the labyrinth on the RSM Campus, the MV campus now has one of its own installed last week thanks to private donors. The design is based on the Medieval Chartres Cathedral labyrinth in France from around 1200 AD. Labyrinths have been used by a wide variety of cultures for at least 3500 years.

Walking a labyrinth offers a pathway to spiritual wholeness. There is no wrong or right way to walk the labyrinth path, just enter and begin following the path. One common method is to use a favorite breath prayer or scripture. As you walk focus on your breath, each inhale and exhale pray, "Breath of God, breathe in me" or "Be still and know that I am God". Walking provides a rhythm that allows us to center on the Holy; letting go of distractions and worries, we become fully present with the Spirit of God. We invite you to try it. Landscaping to beautify the area and a labyrinth instruction sign are projects in progress.

The Prayer Ministry Team gives thanks and praise to God for the donors and those who helped level and prep the area for the installation. For questions please feel free to contact anyone on the Prayer Ministry Team or call the church office.

## Prayer Shawl Ministry - The Knit Wits

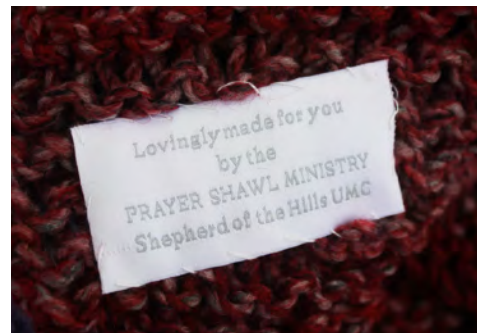

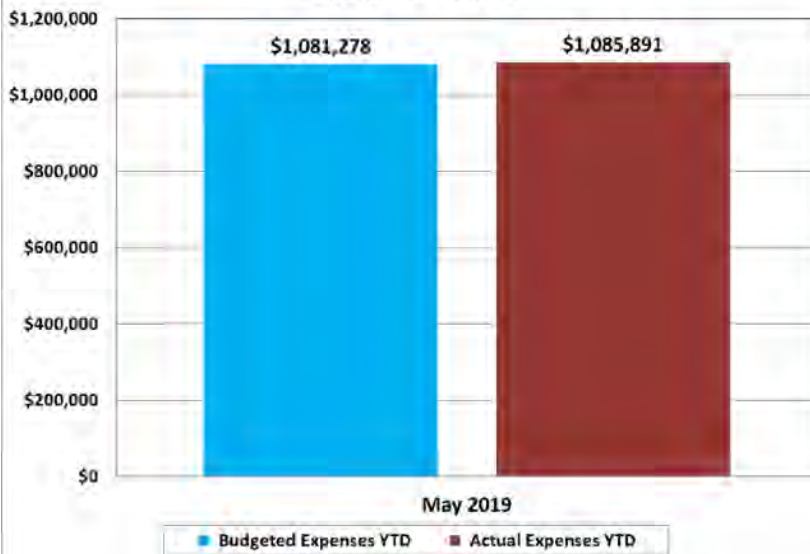

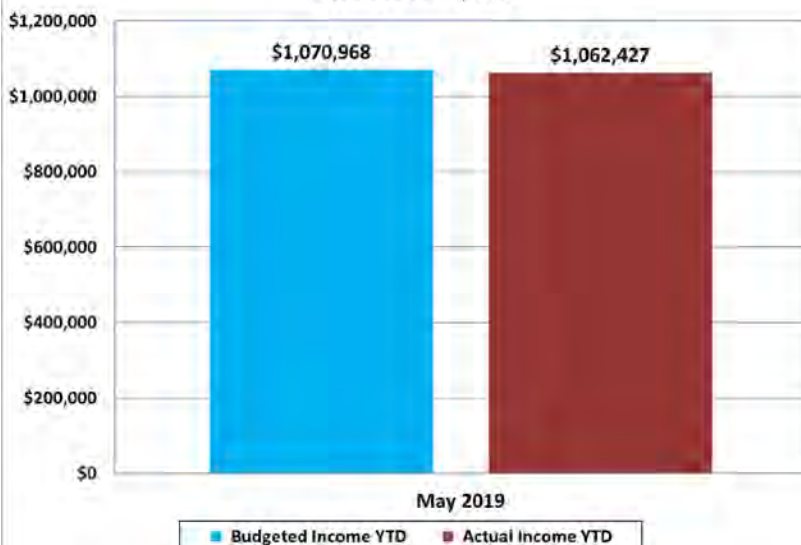
### Commitment Cards
