PASTOR KARL'S MESSAGE

Dear Church Family,

A photograph popped up on my Facebook memories last week. It was a picture of our 2019 Israel Pilgrimage group getting ready to board the bus from our church parking lot. In that image, we were beginning the journey, and while we had a small inkling of what to expect, as always, we could never have imagined what the trip would bring.

Journeys are like that. You begin with an idea of what it might be like. Regardless of that image, the experience often transforms us far beyond what we could ever have imagined.

As I write this, the journey of Lent 2020 is about to begin. Today is Ash Wednesday, and at this moment, we take the first step of what will be a 40-day pilgrimage of Lent. My prayer is that over these 40 days, you will deepen your connection with Jesus as you seek to follow him towards Easter.

For our Lenten study at Mission Viejo, we are using the book Renegade Gospel by Mike

Slaughter. In the opening of the book, he reminds us that discipleship doesn't begin with a profession of faith. It starts by committing to follow Jesus. That's it—no need to state your belief in a creed or doctrine. All you have to do is take the first step and follow.

Slaughter quotes from the book *Resident Aliens* written by Stanley Hauerwas and Bishop

Will Willimon to make the same point. They write,



Early Christians, interestingly, began not with creedal speculation about the metaphysics of the Incarnation—that is, Christology abstracted from the Gospel accounts. They began with the stories about Jesus, about those whose lives got caught up in his life... We cannot know Jesus without following Jesus... [and] In a sense, we follow Jesus before we know Jesus.

Part of my Lenten journey this year is going to be to read through all four gospels over the next 40 days. I want to engage in the stories of Jesus and read about the people whose lives were caught up by the Word made flesh. Perhaps you might do the same. Regardless, my prayer is that these 40 days will bring you closer to Jesus. That by the time we reach Easter, you will have a deeper relationship with the man who gave his life for us. Whether it's by attending Community Table on Wednesdays to serve others, engaging with the *Renegade Gospel* in our Lenten Connect series, or meeting Jesus through our *Even Greater Showman* sermon series, take time to follow the life of Jesus.
