

Those searching for a church and a church community


Those essential workers who must continue to go out and interact in their neighborhood. We pray for their safety, and for all interactions to be filled with grace and love.




The team who continues to bring us a lively and spirit-filled worship every week, connecting to us virtually as they pour their love and energy into sharing God's word.

Rejuvenation, energy and a pouring in of the Holy Spirit for our religious and spiritual leaders.




A lifting of our cares and burdens to God. May we all be comforted by the power of prayer and make time daily to be still and hear God's loving voice.

The friendships and fellowship cherished and nurtured throughout our church family to continue growing, even while we are socially distant.




The groups and committees who continue to meet virtually to seek the word of God and conduct the ministry of our church.

The staff & volunteers of our church, who are dedicated to helping our congregation and anyone who requests it, and who see to the proper maintenance and health of our campus.




All who offer intercessory prayers and lift our world up to God for hope, healing and guidance.

The beauty of God's world and the simple pleasures we enjoy every day.




Scouts, including those who use our church facility to shape and grow youth into faithful servants, intent upon making the world a loving and good place.
