PASTOR JON'S MESSAGE

ne of the things that has always filled my heart with pride as a United Methodist is our emphasis on education (Fun Fact: There are 119 United Methodist colleges and universities in the United States). We United Methodists take seriously Jesus' admonition to "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind." 
