## Town Hall Summary

Dear Church Family,

At our most recent Town Hall meeting, held May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018, we celebrated some of the great things God has been doing in the life of Shepherd of the Hills. We know that not everyone was able to attend, so we wanted to share some of these updates with you by way of this monthly *Happenings* article. God is good and we have much to celebrate.

### New Lay Leadership Team

In November, we talked about a Reset of our Lay Leadership team to allow for more autonomy of campuses while increasing accountability. To do that, we've added a Lay Leader for Gather, Grow, and Give ministries on each campus. This team helps cast vision and direction for the church.

### Financial Update

One of the biggest concerns we shared at our November Town Hall was the ever-increasing cost of our loan. The original loan was an adjustable rate mortgage which had all three properties (RSM, MV, & Parsonage) listed as collateral. At the time, it didn't look like we would be able to refinance the loan into something fixed and/or less expensive.

We are excited to share that we were able—by God's grace—to refinance our debt into a fixed rate mortgage at 4.55%. The monthly cost has dropped, giving us funds to put into a maintenance reserve and to help cover some of the new staffing positions. In addition, the debt is now only secured on the RSM property rather than all three.

### Staffing Changes

We also celebrated the hiring of some new staffing to help grow both of our campuses. At the RSM campus, we have hired Cristina Flores as the Children's Ministry director. She began just after Easter and is focused on the Sunday morning Children's experience. We are also pleased to announce that we have hired Laura Arciniega as our full time Director of Family Ministries & Discipleship at the MV campus. This new position will oversee all children's ministry and be focused on plugging the entire family into the life of our church. In addition, Amy Strawn will serve as our Sunday School Logistics coordinator.

### Renovate Capital Campaign

Our Renovate Capital Campaign was a huge success—again by God's grace! Funds were raised to do 3 things. First, we covered the \$35K budget shortfall. Second, we were able to cover \$15K in unexpected maintenance overages, and third, we raised another \$72K to help renovate the Youth/Children's building at MV and the Sanctuary carpet at RSM. Air conditioning has already been installed in the Youth/Children's building at MV, and we are working on getting the rest of the renovations completed by the end of Summer.

### Next Steps

Over the last couple of months, we've also discovered that there is a need to clarify our expectations of the merger. Through conversations that Pastor Jon and myself have had with various groups within the church, we have come to the conclusion that it is time to complete this merger by drawing up some clear expectations for each campus.

When we met at RSM a few weeks back, we discovered that there is an unexpressed—but very real—fear that campus has centered on the idea that they might be closed down. We also discovered that there are unexpressed expectations about financial responsibilities of our campuses.

Over the next few months, the Lay Leadership team will work to draft a new clarification of the merger agreement. We will share this at a Town Hall meeting in September of this year.

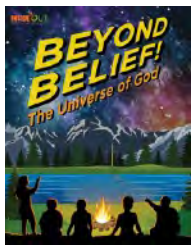

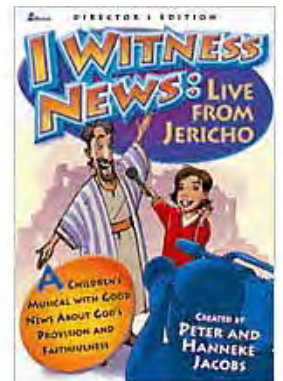

## ***A Catholic Priest on a Methodist campus? WHY NOT?!***



Shepherd of the Hills UMC Prayer & Centering Prayer Ministry are thrilled Father Bill is flying in from Boston to lead a workshop at the Mission Viejo campus. We have experienced him first hand and agree there's a light in him, an authentic sweetness and gentleness that all are drawn to.

Well known Catholic Boston journalist and radio host, Margery Eagan, writes: If Father Bill Sheehan were your parish priest, the pews would be packed for every Mass he said. As it is, he's in huge demand all over the country to lead retreats. And his retreats are packed. He's the best of the best.

Bill Sheehan himself is more modest. "I just think people are searching for something deeper, and sometimes they don't even know how to articulate that," he said at home in Lowell, Massachusetts, where he is a priest with the Oblates of Mary Immaculate. "I'll be flying to a retreat wearing my Oblate cross, reading or preparing. Inevitably the person next to me will ask, 'Where are you going? What are you doing?' 'I'm going to a retreat center in Amarillo (Texas),' I'll say. 'Oh?' I'll tell them I'm a Catholic priest and I'm giving a retreat there and then, boom, Catholic, not Catholic, Christian or not, they want to know all about it! There's a fascination there, a curiosity, maybe even a holy yearning. And they're looking for a deeper relationship with God. There's just that attraction."

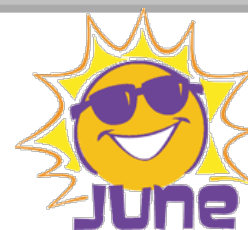

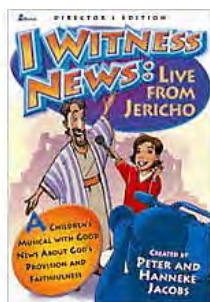
