However, as I talk with people about their summers, it's often centered on a lengthy litany of events, programs, plans, and other things that overload rather than unburden our schedules. In the same way that we've lost the art of taking a sabbath day during the week, we've lost the art of taking the summer to renew.

By the time you read this, you'll be halfway through the summer season. Regardless, my prayer is that you'll take what remains and schedule in a little time to do nothing. Taking sabbath is probably the most broken commandment of the ten commandments given by God to the ancient Israelites. The art of rest has become a lost practice in a culture that pushes us to produce more, achieve more, and be successful at all costs.

As you spend the remaining days of summer, think about building in some intentional down time. God gave us the gift of taking sabbath for a reason. We need renewal. I know this is most definitely true for me and the reason I'll be taking some renewal time during the month of August. We need time to be still and know the presence of God.

While our world continues to accent what is broken and unjust, it makes me realize that in order to respond as followers of Jesus, we need to be renewed. The news can be exhausting. The issues where our responses are needed continue to grow. And we must bring the light of Jesus to so many places in our world it seems. But unless

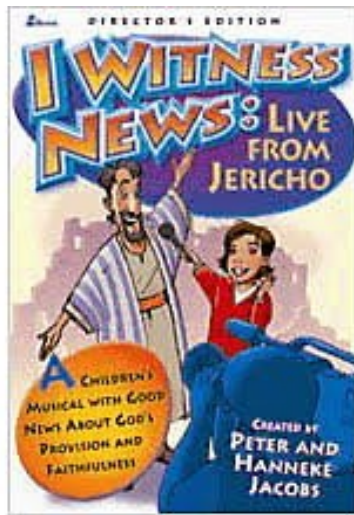

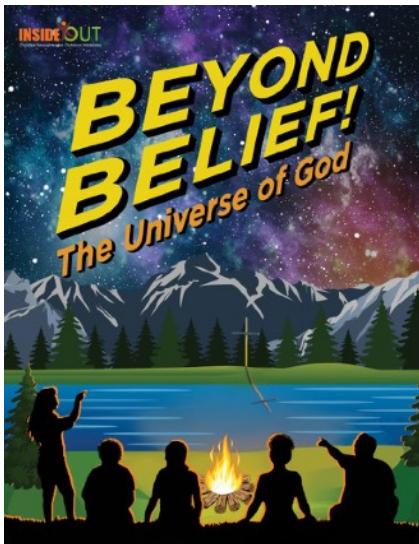

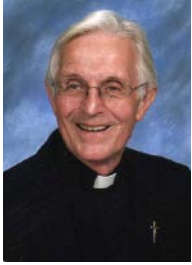

Prayer Shawl Ministry

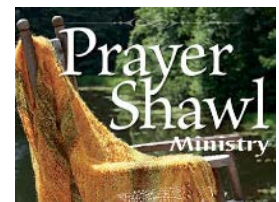
